3	Resolution opposing Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's proposal for a special
4	election.

6	WHEREAS, The Governor of California, Arnold Schwarzenegger campaigned on the
7	pledge that he would stamp out special interest influence on state government; and,
8	WHEREAS, The Governor has recanted on this promise, raising an average of 53,000
9	dollars a day from special interest groups since being elected in a historic recall election; and
10	WHEREAS, The cost for a special election could exceed 70 million dollars, money that
11	should otherwise be spent on health care, reducing class sizes or preserving vital services for
12	Californians; and,
13	WHEREAS, The Governor of California, Arnold Schwarzenegger, is promoting an
14	agenda that is damaging to vital public services and to the employees who provide them; and
15	WHEREAS, California should continue to provide adequate resources to the State's
16	firefighters, police officers, teachers and nurses; and,
17	WHEREAS, Governor Schwarzenegger has proposed numerous measures for the
18	ballot that would threaten funding for California schools as well as other vital services; now
19	therefore be it,
20	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors opposes Governor
21	Schwarzenegger's proposal for a costly statewide special election; and, be it,
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That, following the adoption of this resolution, the Board
23	directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to forward a copy of this resolution to Governor
24	Schwarzenegger and San Francisco representatives in the California State Assembly and
25	Senate.
