3	Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Works to accept and expend a grant of
4	federal Surface Transportation funds in the amount of \$2,000,000 through the
5	Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Transportation for Livable Communities
6	Program for Broadway Streetscape Improvements Project, Phase II, and stating the
7	assurance of the San Francisco Department of Public Works to complete the project.
8	
9	WHEREAS, The Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA 21) (Public Law
10	105-178, June 9, 1998) and the TEA 21 Restoration Act (Public Law 105-206, July 22, 1998)
11	continue the Surface Transportation Program, the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality
12	Improvement Program and the Enhancements Activities Program; and,
13	WHEREAS, Pursuant to TEA 21, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, eligible
14	project sponsors wishing to receive federal transportation grants for a project shall submit an
15	application first with the appropriate metropolitan transportation planning organization (MPO)
16	for review and consideration in the MPO's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and,
17	WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is the San Francisco
18	Bay Area's MPO; and,
19	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Department of Public Works (DPW) is an eligible
20	project sponsor for federal transportation funds; and
21	WHEREAS, DPW wishes to receive federal transportation funds through MTC's
22	Transportation for Livable Communities (TLC) Program's capital grants for the Broadway
23	Streetscape Improvements Project, Phase II; and,
24	WHEREAS, The federal funds will cover 88.5 percent of eligible costs as defined by the
25	Federal Highway Administration and administered by Caltrans; and,

1	WHEREAS, On February 15, 2005, the San Francisco County Transportation Authority			
2	Board passed Resolution 05-43, allocating \$29,000 in Proposition K transportation sales tax			
3	funds to DPW for design engineering of the Broadway Streetscape Improvements Project,			
4	Phase II, and making a commitment to allocate the remaining \$231,000 in construction funds			
5	when DPW completes the design engineering phase, for a total allocation of \$260,000 in local			
6	matching funds, or 11.5 percent of the total project cost; and,			
7	WHEREAS, DPW understands that the federal funding through the TLC program is			
8	fixed at the programmed amount, and therefore any cost increase cannot be expected to be			
9	funded through the TLC program; and			
10	WHEREAS, DPW will complete the project as described in the application, and as			
11	programmed in MTC's TIP; and			
12	WHEREAS, DPW understands that funds must be obligated by June 30, 2006 for TLC			
13	capital projects, or the project may be removed from the program; and,			
14	WHEREAS, DPW proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on project			
15	expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it			
16	RESOLVED, That DPW is authorized to proceed with the federal-aid process with			
17	Caltrans for TLC funding in the amount of \$2,000,000 for the Broadway Streetscape			
18	Improvements Project, Phase II; and be it			
19	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the required local matching funds in the amount of			
20	\$260,000, or 11.5 percent of the total project cost, will be provided by Proposition K			
21	transportation sales tax funds; and be it			
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPW understands that the TLC Program funding for the			
23	project is fixed at \$2,000,000, and that any cost increases must be funded by DPW from local			

matching funds, and that DPW does not expect any cost increases to be funded through the

TLC program; and

2	II, will be built as described in this resolution and submitted application and, if approved, for				
3	the amount shown in MTC'S TIP with obligation occurring within the timeframe established				
4	below; and be it				
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the federal funds will be obligated by June 30, 2006 for				
6	this TLC capital project; and be it				
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the				
8	Director of the Department of Public Works to accept and expend \$2,000,000 in federal funds				
9	through the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Transportation for Livable				
10	Communities Program for Broadway Streetscape Improvements Project, Phase II, and to				
11	execute all documents therefor
