10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	
12	Section 1. Findings. The Planning Department has determined that the actions
13	contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality
14	Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file
15	with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated
16	herein by reference.
17	
18	Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
19	Section 8.14, to read as follows:
20	SEC. 8.14. MEDICAL EXAMINER'S FEES FOR COPIES OF DOCUMENTS AND CERTAIN
21	SERVICES.
22	(a) The Medical Examiner is hereby authorized to charge fees to defray the cost of the
23	issuance of the following mentioned documents and the providing of the following services.

1	(b) Beginning with fiscal year 2003-2004, fees set in this Section may be adjusted
2	each year, without further action by the Board of Supervisors, to reflect changes in the
3	relevant Consumer Price Index, as determined by the Controller.
4	No later than April 15 <sup>th</sup> of each year, the Medical Examiner's Office shall submit its
5	current fee schedule to the Controller, who shall apply the price index adjustment to produce
6	a new fee schedule for the following year.
7	No later than May 15 <sup>th</sup> of each year, the Controller shall file a report with the Board of
8	Supervisors reporting the new fee schedule and certifying that: (a) the fees produce sufficient
9	revenue to support the costs of providing the services for which each fee is assessed, and (b)
10	the fees do not produce revenue which is significantly more than the costs of providing the
11	services for which each fee is assessed.
12	(c) All fees received for documents and services mentioned in this Section shall be
13	deposited with the Treasurer and shall be used to defray the costs incurred by the Medical
14	Examiner in issuing such documents or providing such services.
