10	Restoration Act continue the Surface Transportation Program (STP) and the Congestion		
11	Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ); and,		
12	WHEREAS, The TEA21 legislation will guide STP, CMAQ, and Transportation		
13	Enhancements programming until a TEA-21 Reauthorization bill is authorized; and,		
14	WHEREAS, Pursuant to TEA-21, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, eligible		
15	project sponsors wishing to receive STP or CMAQ grants for a project shall submit an		
16	application first with the appropriate metropolitan transportation planning organization (MPO),		
17	for review and inclusion in the MPO's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and,		
18	WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission is the MPO for the San		
19	Francisco Bay region; and,		
20	WHEREAS, DPW is an eligible project sponsor for STP or CMAQ funds; and		
21	WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority, on behalf of the City		
22	and County of San Francisco, submitted an application to MTC for Additional FY 2004-05		
23	Federal STP/CMAC funds – Cycle 1 Funding Augmentation from the STP Improvement		
24	Program in Fiscal Year 2004-05 for the following projects: \$1,500,000 for the North Point		
25	Street Pavement Renovation Project and \$600,000 for the Monterey Boulevard Pavement

1 Renovation Project, or a total of \$2,100,000 in Additional Federal STP/CMAQ funds and, 2 WHEREAS, The federal funding will cover 88.5 percent of eligible costs up to total 3 project costs of \$2,372,881 as defined by the Federal Highway Administration and 4 administered by Caltrans; and, 5 WHEREAS, The non-federal share will be paid for with local half-cent sales tax 6 administered by the San Francisco County Transportation Authority; and, 7 WHEREAS, The non-federal share of the total costs of the projects is \$1,941,250 8 which is greater than the required 11.5 percent local match; and, 9 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works understands that the total amount of STP 10 funding for the aforementioned projects is fixed at \$2,100,000, and that any cost increases 11 incurred by the Department in delivering these projects must be funded by local funds, and 12 that the Department of Public Works does not expect any cost increases to be funded with STP funds; and, 13 14 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works will complete the project as described in 15 the application and as programmed in MTC's TIP; and, 16 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works understands that funds must be obligated by June 30 of the year that the projects are programmed for in the TIP, or the projects may be 17 18 removed from the program; and, WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has a certified pavement management 19 20 system (PMS); and, 21 WHEREAS, There is no legal impediment to the Department of Public Works making 22 applications for STP funds; and, 23 WHEREAS, There is no pending or threatened litigation which might in any way 24 adversely affect the proposed projects, or the ability of the Department of Public Works to 25 deliver such projects; now, therefore, be it Supervisors Peskin, Elsbernd
