15	The Department of Human Services shall not require fingerprint imaging of clients in order to
16	access services, unless required by State, Federal, or grant programs, or those required by voter
17	initiative, or the County Adult Assistance Programs including Personal Assistance Employment
18	Services (PAES), Supplemental Security Income Pending (SSIP), Cash Assistance Linked to MediCal
19	(CALM), and General Assistance (GA).
