5	Resolution honoring Dr. Donald Abrams and the Community Consortium for their
6	outstanding contributions to HIV/AIDS healthcare and research upon the 20 <sup>th</sup>
7	anniversary of the Consortium's establishment.

9	WHEREAS, Dr. Donald Abrams founded the University of California San Francisco
10	Community Consortium in 1985 to provide a forum for community-based primary care
11	physicians and their colleagues in the UCSF AIDS Program at San Francisco General
12	Hospital (SFGH) to share the latest information on the most effective treatments for HIV
13	disease, and to learn about clinical trials of promising experimental therapies being conducted
14	at SFGH; and
15	WHEREAS, The Community Consortium has grown more than ten fold in the last 20
16	years and now includes approximately 250 physicians, nurses and other health care providers
17	who, collectively, care for the majority of people with HIV infection in the San Francisco Bay
18	Area and who continue to meet on a monthly basis to discuss clinical issues in the
19	management of HIV disease and the results of the latest research on new experimental
20	therapies; and,
21	WHEREAS, Over the last 20 years, Dr. Abrams and the Consortium have achieved
22	their mission by furnishing primary care providers in the Bay Area with the latest information
23	on the most effective treatments for HIV disease, by evaluating a broad range of promising
24	treatments and treatment strategies, and by influencing public policy that directly impacts the
25	provision of primary medical care to people with HIV infection; now, therefore, be it

2	honors Dr. Donald Abrams and the Community Consortium for outstanding contributions to
