| 11 | provider of hospital services based in San Francisco; and, |
| 12 | WHEREAS, CHW is committed to the promotion of public / private partnerships whose |
| 13 | goal is to enhance and protect the provision of health care services, particularly for the |
| 14 | medically underserved; and, |
| 15 | WHEREAS, Saint Francis and St. Mary's hospitals have been engaged with the San |
| 16 | Francisco Department of Public Health (The Department) in identifying and evaluating |
| 17 | potential areas of collaboration; and, |
| 18 | WHEREAS, The Department and the hospitals have established collaborative |
| 19 | relationships that have improved access to health care services through increased primary |
| 20 | care referrals and integration with The Department's Lifetime Clinical Record, among other |
| 21 | projects; and, |
| 22 | WHEREAS, CHW has developed a leading patient financial assistance policy to |
| 23 | address increasing health care costs and protect access to care for people who find it difficult |
| 24 | to pay for health services; and, |
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| 1 | WHEREAS, CHW has developed an innovative tool, the Community Needs Index |
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| 2 | (CNI), to accurately identify community-wide health needs so that resources can be directed |
| 3 | to improve health in order to avoid unnecessary hospitalizations; and, |
| 4 | WHEREAS, The Department and the hospitals have signed a formal Memorandum of |
| 5 | Understanding (MOU) to promote further joint service planning that could lead to expanded |
| 6 | relationships focused on securing safety-net services to vulnerable populations; now, |
| 7 | therefore, be it |
| 8 | RESOLVED, That CHW, Saint Francis and St. Mary's hospitals are to be commended |
| 9 | for their commitment to working with The Department to protect and enhance the provision of |
| 10 | health care services to vulnerable populations, and therefore be it |
| 11 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That other hospital service providers within the City and |
| 12 | County of San Francisco be encouraged to emulate these efforts and engage with The |
| 13 | Department in developing innovative and long-lasting public – private partnerships vital to the |
