3	Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic to install speed humps to
4	prevent unlawful and dangerous driving on Linden Street between Webster Street and
5	Buchanan Street and on Rose Street between Webster Street and Buchanan Street.
6	Buohanan etreet and en riese etreet between webster etreet and Buohanan etreet.

8	WHEREAS, Linden Street between Webster Street and Buchanan Street, and Rose
9	Street between Webster Street and Buchanan Street are frequently used for illegal
10	exhibitions of speed, including "peeling out" and "donuts"; and,
11	WHEREAS, The portion of the Western Addition and Hayes Valley neighborhoods at
12	
13	issue experience heavy pedestrian traffic, and children often play around and utilize these
14	streets; and,
15	WHEREAS, More than 100 children live in the Hayes Valley Public Housing complex,
16	and there is a park and a child care center at the nearby intersection of Hayes Street and
17	Buchanan Street; and,
18	WHEREAS, Residents and merchants in the area are concerned about drug dealing
19	and other illegal activity in the area, and these activities have an apparent relationship to the
20 21	illegal driving addressed by this resolution; and,
22	WHEREAS, Residents and merchants are concerned about pedestrian safety in the
23	neighborhoods and roads addressed by this resolution and have requested that the City
24	implement traffic calming measures; and,
