3	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to		
4	accept retroactively and expend three grants in the total amount of \$4,606.18 from the		
5	California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) for organic foods (\$1,000), egg		
6	quality control (\$2,256.18), and weighmasters (\$1,350) programs, and to enter into		
7	agreements for the use of these funds; for the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30,		
8	2006.

10	WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded three small grants in the total		
11	amount of \$4,606.18 from CDFA for food related programs; and,		
12	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDFA requires the City to		
13	enter into three agreements (The "Agreements") copies of which are on file with the Clerk of		
14	the Board of Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part		
15	of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
16	WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors		
17	because the Department was not forwarded the State Standard Agreements covering these		
18	funds until after July 1, 2005; and,		
19	WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds		
20	may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually		
21	considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure		
22	of grant funding; and,		
23	WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budgets; now,		
24	therefore, be it

2	three grants in the total amount of \$4,606.18 from CDFA; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of

5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the		
6	grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreements pursuant to the		
7	San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it		
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
9	Agreements on behalf of the City.
