16	be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of		
17	not more than \$500.		
18	(b) Any person violating violation of the provisions of Section 41.15, 41.18(c) or 41.19		
19	of this Article shall be deemed guilty of an infraction and upon conviction thereof shall be		
20	punishable by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$50100.		
21	Section 2. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in		
22	this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California		
23	Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of		
24	the Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by reference.
