13 WHEREAS, 17% of California’s jobs are created by these small storefronts,  
14 restaurants, and home-based businesses; and,

15 WHEREAS, By supporting these micro-businesses with training to build successful,  
16 sustainable and smart businesses, we can ensure a more stable foundation for our local  
17 economy and enjoy vibrant neighborhoods; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
19 declares October 2005 as “Microenterprise Development Month” in the City and County of
