Resolution urging Walgreens Boots Alliance Inc. to engage in good-faith negotiations and quickly reach a fair and equitable contract with the United Food and Commercial Workers International Union, Local 648, employed by Walgreens Boots Alliance Inc.

WHEREAS, The United Food and Commercial Workers International Union ("UFCW") Local 648 is an American labor union representing primarily grocery workers and drug-division workers; and

WHEREAS, The UFCW Local 648 has approximately 4,000 members, of which 1,500 work at Walgreens, here in the City and County of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Walgreens Boots Alliance Inc. is an American holding company headquartered in Deerfield, Illinois, that owns Walgreens, Boots, and a number of pharmaceutical manufacturing, wholesale, and distribution companies; and

WHEREAS, Walgreens Boots Alliance Inc. has 68 locations in the City and County of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Walgreens Boots Alliance Inc. was formed on December 31, 2014, after Walgreens purchased the 55% stake in UK and Switzerland-based Alliance Boots that it did not already own, the total price of acquisition was \$4.9 billion in cash; and

WHEREAS, On October 2018, Walgreens Boots Alliance Inc. published its fourth quarter earnings report, fiscal year 2018 sales were \$131.5 billion, up 11.3% from fiscal year 2017; and

WHEREAS, The UFCW Local 648 bargaining team has identified bargaining priorities, including securing improving wages, paid time off, health care, and no take aways (i.e., no reduction in health benefits); and
