8	Commission by motion adopted a Final Mitigated Negative Declaration for 680 Illinois

10	Section 31.11(h). A copy of said document is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
11	Supervisors in File No. 051740 and is incorporated by reference herein; and,
12	WHEREAS, The Clerk of the Board received an appeal by Mark R. Wolf on behalf of
13	the Carpenters Union Local 22 and Tom McCarthy on October 19, 2005 ("Appellants"); and
14	WHEREAS, This Board of Supervisor's held a duly noticed public hearing on
15	November 15, 2005, to consider the negative declaration appeal filed by Appellants.
16	Following the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board reversed the Planning Commission's
17	adoption of the negative declaration for 680 Illinois Street/2075 Third Street based on the
18	written record before the Board as well as all of the testimony at the public hearing in support
19	of and opposed to the appeal. Said Motion and written record is in the Clerk of the Board of
20	Supervisors File No. 051740 and is incorporated herein as though set forth in its entirety; and
21	WHEREAS, In regard to said decision, this Board made certain findings specifying the
22	basis for its decision; now, therefore, be it
