8	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
9	Section 1. Findings
10	The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that 2151 Van Ness Avenue, St. Brigid Church,
11	Lot 015 in Assessor's Block 0575, has a special character and special historical, architectural
12	and aesthetic interest and value, and that its designation as a Landmark will further the
13	purposes of and conform to the standards set forth in Article 10 of the City Planning Code.
14	(a) <u>Designation</u> : Pursuant to Section 1004 of the City Planning Code, 2151 Van Ness
15	Avenue, St. Brigid Church, is hereby designated as Landmark No. 252. This designation was
16	initiated by Resolution 227-05 of the Board of Supervisors and has been fully approved by
17	Resolution No. 587 of the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board and Resolution No. 17128
18	of the Planning Commission, which Resolutions are on file with the Clerk of the Board of
19	Supervisors under File No. 051772 and which Resolutions are incorporated herein and made
20	part hereof as though fully set forth.
21	(b) Priority Policy Findings
22	(1) Pursuant to Planning Code Section 302, this Board of Supervisors finds that this
23	ordinance will serve the public necessity, convenience and welfare for the reasons set forth in
24	Planning Commission Resolution No. 17128 recommending approval of this Planning Code

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- Amendment, and incorporates such reasons by this reference thereto. A copy of said resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 051772.
  - (2) Pursuant to Planning Code Section 101.1, this Board of Supervisors finds that this ordinance is consistent with the Priority Policies of Section 101.1(b) of the Planning Code and with the General Plan and hereby adopts the findings of the Planning Commission, as set forth in Planning Commission Resolution No. 16982-17128, and incorporates said findings by this reference thereto.

## (c) Required Data:

- (1) The description, location and boundary of the Landmark site encompass the footprint of 2151 Van Ness Avenue, St. Brigid Church.
- (2) The characteristics of the Landmark which that justify its designation are described and shown in the Landmark Designation Report adopted by the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board on May 4, 2005 and other supporting materials contained in Planning Department Docket No. 2005.0301L. In brief, the National Register and Article 10 characteristics of the landmark which that justify its designation are as follows:
- (i) Its association with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history by virtue of the building's importance to San Francisco's Irish community (Criterion A); and
- (ii) its embodiment of distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction as a perfectly preserved special architectural character and aesthetic interest as an example of Romanesque Revival-inspired architecture designed by Shea and Shea and Henry A. Minton, because of its use of San Francisco curbstones and crossing stones in the construction of the façade, and because of its high artistic value (Criterion C).
- (3) The particular exterior features that should be preserved, or replaced in-kind as determined necessary, are those generally shown in the photographs and described in the

1	Landmark Designation Report, both of which can be found in the case docket 2005.0301L,
2	which is incorporated in this designation ordinance as though fully set forth. In brief, the
3	description of the particular features that should be preserved are is the four elevations of the
4	church, which includes all architectural finishes, features, and fabric on the exterior of the
5	building including the stain <u>ed glass windows.</u>
6	Section 2. The property shall be subject to further controls and procedures, pursuant
7	to this Board of Supervisor's Ordinance and Planning Code Article 10.
