MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby adds Rule 1.1.1 to its Rules of Order, to read as follows:

## 1.1.1. PUBLIC TESTIMONY PROVISIONS.

The Brown Act and Sunshine Ordinance provide that the Board of Supervisors may adopt reasonable regulations related to public testimony. These regulations may include limitations on the total amount of time allocated to each member of the public during the public comment portion of Board meetings, and limitations on the total amount of time allocated to each member of the public for public testimony during Committee sessions on particular issues. The Sunshine Ordinance gives every person the right to address a Committee on each item prior to action on the item, or to address the Board on an item if no Committee hearing was held on the item before the Board for action. Time limits imposed on individual speakers shall be applied uniformly to members of the public wishing to testify. In furtherance of these principles, the Board of Supervisors and its committees shall not allow public speakers to donate their allotted public speaking time to other public speakers, since donated time would allow a recipient speaker to speak for a longer period of time than other public speakers are allowed to speak. The use of videotapes and audiotapes during public testimony at Board and committee meetings can be disruptive to the proceedings and to the rights of other speakers. The Board discourages the use of videotapes and audiotapes during public testimony at Board and committee meetings except when necessary to enable a
