10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

12	Section 1. Ordinance No. 203-05, the Consolidated Budget and Annual Appropriation
13	Ordinance appropriating all estimated receipts and all estimated expenditures for the City and
14	County of San Francisco for fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, is hereby amended by adding
15	Section 32, to read as follows:
16	
17	Sec. 32. Business Improvement Districts. Proceeds from all special assessments levied on real
18	property included in the property-based business improvement districts in the City and County of San
19	Francisco are hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006 in the respective amounts
20	actually received by the City and County in such fiscal year for each such district. The Controller is
21	authorized to disburse the assessment revenues appropriated by this section to the respective Owners'
22	Associations (as defined in Section 36614.5 of the Streets and Highways Code) for such districts as
23	provided in the management district plans, resolutions establishing the districts, annual budgets and
24	management agreements, as approved by the Board of Supervisors for each such district, for the
25	purposes authorized therein, as follows:
