3	Ordinance adding section 1.112.5 to Article I, Chapter 1 of the Campaign and
4	Governmental Conduct Code to require electronic disclosure of campaign
5	contributions received by candidates for City Elective Office during the final forty-five
6	days before an election at which the candidate's name will appear on the ballot.

10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. The San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby
12	amended by adding Section 1.112.5, to read as follows:
13	SEC. 1.112.5. ELECTRONIC REPORTS OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS
14	(a) <b>Disclosure Requirement.</b> Within 45 days of an election, any candidate for City elective
15	office whose name will appear on the ballot at that election and who has received \$1,000 in campaign
16	contributions, shall file an electronic report with the Ethics Commission within 24 hours of receiving a
17	campaign contribution of \$100 or more disclosing:
18	(1) The total amount of the contribution; and
19	(2) The contributor's full name, street address, occupation, employer, or, if self-employed,
20	the name of the contributor's business.
21	(b) <b>Format.</b> The disclosure requirement imposed by subsection (a) shall not apply until the
22	Ethics Commission has prescribed a format for the electronic reports required by that subsection. The
23	Ethics Commission shall prescribe an electronic format for reports required by subsection (a) within
24	90 days of the effective date of this section.
