1	[Forty-Five Day Electronic Reports of Campaign Funds.]

3	Ordinance adding section 1.112.5 to Article I, Chapter 1 of the Campaign and
4	Governmental Conduct Code to require electronic disclosure of campaign funds
5	received by candidates for City Elective Office during the final forty-five days before an
6	election at which the candidate's name will appear on the ballot.

8	deletions are strikethrough italies Times New Roman. Board amendment additions are double underlined.
9	Board amendment deletions are strikethrough normal.
10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. The San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby
12	amended by adding Section 1.112.5, to read as follows:
13	SEC. 1.112.5. FORTY-FIVE DAY ELECTRONIC REPORTS OF CAMPAIGN FUNDS
14	(a) Disclosure Requirement. In addition to any other report required by this Chapter, each
15	candidate for City elective office who has received a cumulative total of \$10,000 in public funds,
16	monetary contributions and in-kind contributions shall file daily electronic reports with the Ethics
17	Commission during the final 45 days before an election at which the candidate's name will appear on
18	the ballot. Such reports shall be filed by midnight of each day up to and including the day of the
19	election and shall disclose:
20	(1) The total amount of public funds, monetary contributions and in-kind contributions, if
21	any, the candidate received before midnight of the previous day; and
22	(2) For each monetary or in-kind contribution of \$100 or more, the total amount of the
23	contribution, and contributor's full name, street address, occupation, employer, or, if self-employed, the
24	name of the contributor's business.

1	(b) Format. The disclosure requirement imposed by subsection (a) shall not apply until the
2	Ethics Commission has prescribed a format for the electronic reports required by that subsection. The
3	Ethics Commission shall prescribe an electronic format for reports required by subsection (a) within
4	90 days of the effective date of this section.
