sale general public premises license from 1695 Market Street to 86 Second Street for M

& M Group Assets, Inc. dba DaDa SF Studio, will serve the public convenience and

24 necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

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Conditions: (1) The premises shall be maintained as a bona fide art gallery (a room or building devoted to the exhibition of works of art) with the sale of beer, wine and distilled spirits. The premises shall be used for no other purpose. (2) The petitioner(s) shall stock and offer for sale a substantial assortment of art and/or merchandise commonly associated with and sold to persons in the community. (3) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited. (4) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (5) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee. (6) The petitioner(s) shall not display any magazine, video, printed or painted material, which contains pictures depicting: (a) Acts or simulated acts or sexual act, which are prohibited by law. (b) Any person being touched, caressed or fondled in a manner prohibited by law. (c) Scenes wherein artificial devices or inanimate objects are employed to depict, or drawings are employed to portray, any other prohibited activities described above. (7) No pool or billiard tables may be maintained on the premises. (8) There shall be no coin operated games or video machines upon the premises at anytime. (9) There shall be no exterior advertising or sign of any type, including advertising to the exterior from within, promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic beverages. Interior displays of alcoholic beverages or signs, which are clearly visible to the exterior, shall constitute a violation of this condition. (10) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall not be permitted only between the hours of 12:00 noon to 12:00 midnight Sunday through Wednesday and 12:00 noon to 2:00 a.m. Thursday through Saturday. (11) Petitioner(s) shall regularly police the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons about the premises.

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
