12	Section 1. Findings.		
13	The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this		
14	Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public		
15	Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.).		
16	Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.4		
17	to read as follows:		
18	<u>SEC. 12.4112.42. STADIUM RENTALS.</u>		
19	The General Mana	ger is authorized to enter into short-term, not to exceed 14 cumulative days,	
20	revocable license agreements, for the use of Kezar Stadium, Kezar Pavilion, Boxer Pavilion Stadiun		
21	and the Stadium at Candlestick Point at rates that reflect market rates for comparable events at		
22	comparable Bay Area venues, provided that prior to the commencement of the license the		
23	licensee shall tender in full all sums due under the license and shall provide to the City a		
24	sufficient security deposit, in the form of cash, a letter of credit or other instrument, to protect		
25	the City in the event of loss or damage to the City in connection with the license.
