2	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) to accept and
3	
4	expend \$375,311 in grant funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency
5	(FEMA) for the development and implementation of a fire safety and prevention
6	program for senior citizens.
7	
8	WHEREAS, Individuals over the age of 60 make up more than 17% of San Francisco's
9	population and by the year 2030 that number is projected to almost double; and,
10	WHEREAS, Senior citizens are 30% of all fire fatalities and 11% of fire-related injuries;
11	and
	WHEREAS, 75% of seniors hospitalized due to injury were hurt in falls; and,
12	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department has applied for and been awarded a
13	grant from FEMA to improve public education to seniors through the development and
14	implementation of a targeted fire safety and prevention program; and,
15	WHEREAS, based on grant criteria, the Department's grant application included the
16	participation of the Department of Public Health (DPH) and the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn
17	Foundation (AARBF), a local nonprofit agency dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for
18	burn survivors and to promote burn prevention; and
19	WHEREAS, The SFFD proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program
20	expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; and,
21	WHEREAS, The funds received must be expended no later than February 22, 2007,
22	unless an extension is requested and granted; now, therefore, be it
23	RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby waives inclusion of
24	indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it
25	manoot oooto m the grant budget, and be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Fire Department is hereby authorized
2	to accept and expend grant funds in the amount of \$375,111 from the Federal Emergency
3	Management Agency; and be it
4	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco appoints the Chief
5	of the San Francisco Fire Department as agent to conduct all negotiations and execute and
6	submit all documents, including but not limited to grant agreements, which will be necessary
7	for the completion of the grant.
