6	WHEREAS, The Juvenile Probation Department desires to participate in the
7	Juvenile Probation and Camps Funding (JPCF) Program administered by the
8	Corrections Standards Authority (hereafter referred to as CSA); and
9	WHEREAS, This JPCF Program replaces the existing TANF (Temporary Assistance to
10	Needy Families) Program funding authorized under the California Youth Services Act of over
11	\$3.3 million.
12	WHEREAS, This funding is used to pay for direct therapeutic and rehabilitation
13	services to children through Community-Based Organizations and other professional service
14	providers; now, therefore, be it
15	RESOLVED, That the Juvenile Probation Department of the City and County of San
16	Francisco is authorized to enter into the attached JPCF Program Agreement on behalf of the
17	City; and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That William P. Siffermann, Chief Probation Officer of the San
19	Francisco Juvenile Probation Department is authorized to sign the attached JPCF Program
20	Agreement with the CSA on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, including any extensions or
21	amendments thereof; and, be it
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco agrees to abide by
23	the statutes governing the JPCF Program as well as the terms and conditions of the
24	Agreement as set forth by the CSA, including the retention of financial records substantiating
25	claimed expenditures and the submission of Semi-Annual Progress Reports.
