Review all consideration points including parking lot, near open space and public parks.

Conditions for approval for consideration.

Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 am to 10pm daily.

No more than 5% of the square footage of the premise will be used for the display of the alcoholic beverages.

Sales of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 40oz, or similar size containers is prohibited.

No prepackaged beer or malt beverages shall be sold as a single unit.

Liquor licensee holder should be instructed on good neighbor policies for neighborhood, city and state.

Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml.

Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257.

The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control.
