11	WHEREAS, At a press conference for Operation Jumpstart in Southern Texas, the
12	United States Border Patrol refused to answer questions that were asked in Spanish; and,
13	WHEREAS, The State Legislature of Arizona is also considering banning
14	undocumented immigrants from purchasing property in the State of Arizona; and,
15	WHEREAS, San Francisco too has a distinct cultural heritage that is worthy of
16	maintaining and protecting; and,
17	WHEREAS, That cultural heritage is under attack from immigrant groups like Latinos
18	and speakers of other foreign languages such as Sanskrit, who by refusing to learn
19	grammatically correct English are deteriorating America's English language heritage; and,
