8	benefits and working conditions as drivers at Safeway and Albertsons; and
9	WHEREAS, Whole Foods of California Incorporated has met with Teamsters Local 278
10	three times since May and is scheduled to meet three more times in August; and,
11	WHEREAS, Numerous unfair labor practices have been filed with the National Labor
12	Relations Board against Whole Foods of California Incorporated; and,
13	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors has a long history of working to
14 15	safeguard labor standards and employment rights of workers inside and outside of San
16	Francisco; and,
17	WHEREAS, In recent years and months the San Francisco Board of Supervisors has
	supported the passage of minimum wage and health care legislation; now, therefore, be it
18	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby supports the efforts
19	of Teamsters Local 278 in negotiating a collective bargaining agreement with Whole Foods of
20	California Incorporated; and, be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges Whole
22	Foods of California Incorporated to act in good faith and come to an agreement with
23	Teamsters Local 278 in the near future.
