3	Resolution urging the San Francisco Sheriff's Department to collect data on the
4	number of Ellis Act evictions it enforces by adding a checkbox on its eviction
5	instruction form to disclose that the eviction is an Ellis Act eviction.
6	
7	WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 7060, otherwise known as the Ellis
8	Act, provides that all tenants in a building can be evicted if the landlord will not rent the units
9	in the future but does not prohibit the units from being sold; and
10	WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 7060 has become a mechanism for
11	landlords to evict tenants for the purpose of selling the units as condominium-type units and
12	circumventing the intent of the San Francisco Subdivision Code, including provisions which
13	would prohibit the eviction of senior and disabled tenants for condominium-type units; and
14	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff's Department is responsible for carrying out
15	evictions in the City and County of San Francisco; and
16	WHEREAS, Over the last two years, the Sheriff's Department has enforced an
17	averaged of 1400 evictions per year; and
18	WHEREAS, Over the last two years, as the San Francisco real estate market has
19	exploded, the rate of Ellis Act evictions has doubled with 286 units being evicted in 2004 and
20	299 units in 2005; and
21	WHEREAS, Considering an average of 2.1 people per apartment in San Francisco,
22	over 600 people have lost their homes to Ellis Act evictions in of each the last two years; and
23	WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department does not currently maintain data on the numbe
24	of evictions it enforces that are due to the Ellis Act; and

1	WHEREAS, In order to better understand the impact that the Ellis Act has on the
2	people of San Francisco, it is important to track the number of Ellis Act evictions the Sheriff's
3	Department enforces; and
4	WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has taken a thoughtful and humane approach to
5	carrying out evictions; and
6	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco Sheriff's
7	Department to collect data on the number of Ellis Act evictions it enforces by adding a
8	checkbox on its eviction instruction form disclosing that the eviction is an Ellis Act eviction.
