11	Section 1. Article 9 of the San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is			
12	hereby amended by amending Section 615 to read as follows:

15	Authority of Tax Collector Generally; Parking Tax Fund_Deposit of Collections to General			
16	<i><u>Fund</u></i> . The Tax Collector shall enforce the provisions of this Article and may prescribe, adopt			
17	and enforce rules and regulations relating to the administration and enforcement of this			
18	Article. The Tax Collector may prescribe the extent to which any ruling or regulation shall be			
19	applied without retroactive effects.			
20	The Tax Collector shall transmit all moneys collected pursuant to this Article to the			
21	Treasurer for deposit to the General Fund and, subject to the budget and fiscal provisions of the

4	the balance of the moneys collected shall be used exclusively for senior citizens' programs, provided,
5	however that appropriations for said senior citizens' programs shall be made by the Board of
6	Supervisors pursuant to the budget and fiscal provisions of the Charter; and further provided that no
7	portion of these funds shall be used for the studies or consultant services for senior citizens' services
8	and programs; and provided further that the Board of Supervisors shall expend a portion of said funds
9	for the continual auditing and monitoring of all senior citizens' programs by the Budget Analyst.
