1	[Board of Appeals: Legal Representation for Planning and Building Departments.]
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3	Ordinance amending the San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code by adding
4	Section 11(a) to establish a procedure for the City Attorney to provide legal
5	representation for staff of the Planning Department and Department of Building
6	Inspection appearing at hearings of the Board of Appeals with respect to certain
7	matters.

11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
12	Section 1. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
13	by adding Section 11(a), to read as follows:
14	SEC. 11(a) CITY ATTORNEY - REPRESENTATION OF PLANNING AND BUILDING
15	<u>DEPARTMENT STAFF.</u>
16	For appeals from decisions of the Planning Commission, the Zoning Administrator, the
17	Building Inspection Commission, and the Planning and Building Departments, the following procedure
18	shall be followed by staff to ensure that there is adequate legal advocacy on behalf of those
19	departments in matters that involve important public policy or legal significance.
20	(1) Staff of the Board of Appeals shall send to the deputy city attorney who has been
21	designated by the City Attorney to be counsel to the Planning Department and the Department of
22	Building Inspection a copy of (1) the advance or draft agendas at regular intervals and the final
23	agenda for each meeting as soon as it is prepared, (2) all Notices of Appeal within 5 working days of
24	when they are received by the staff of the Board of Appeals; and (3) any brief submitted to the Board of
25	Appeals immediately upon receipt by the staff of the Board of Appeals.

1	(2) The Zoning Administrator, Planning Department staff, and the Building Department
2	staff member assigned to the Board of Appeals shall consult with their designated deputy city attorney
3	concerning any appeals of decisions involving their respective commissions or departments.
4	(3) The department staff representative shall determine whether an appeal presents any
5	issues of important public policy and the City Attorney's Office shall have the discretion to determine
6	whether an appeal presents any issues of legal significance. The City Attorney's Office shall have the
7	discretion to determine what level of participation by the City Attorney's Office is appropriate in order
8	to defend the department's decision before the Board of Appeals. The applicable Department will
9	allow for the City Attorney's Office representation based on that determination.
10	The criteria used to make these determinations shall include, but not be limited to, whether the
11	<u>appeal:</u>
12	(a) challenges a decision of the Planning Commission or Building Inspection Commission;
13	(b) challenges a Zoning Administrator interpretation of a provision of the Planning Code;
14	(c) involves a matter that is likely to lead to litigation;
15	(d) raises novel issues of law.
16	The services of the City Attorney's Office in advising and representing the Planning Department,
17	including the Zoning Administrator, and Building Department in matters before the Board of Appeals
18	shall be funded by those departments and not chargeable to the Board of Appeals.
19	(4) The Zoning Administrator, Planning Department staff, and the Building Department
20	staff member assigned to the Board of Appeals shall ensure that Section 10 of the Business and Tax
21	Regulations Code is complied with such that the complete record from the department whose decision
22	is being appealed from shall be made available to each Commissioner at least one week before the
23	hearing on the appeal. Any staff report that was prepared below shall be included in the packet for
24	each hearing.
