15	Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of application before		
16	submission of said application to the State; and,		
17	WHEREAS, The applicant will enter into an agreement with the State of California to		
18	complete the project; and		
19	WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now		
20	therefore, be it		
21	RESOLVED that the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby		
22	approves the acceptance and expenditure of local assistance in the amount of \$220,000 for		
23	improvements to the trails encasing Pine Lake; and, be it

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1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco waives inclusion of		
2	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco certifies that		
4	Grantee has reviewed, understands and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the		
5	Contract shown in the Procedural Guide; and, be it		
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco certifies that		
7	Grantee has or will have available prior to commencement of any work on the project included		
8	in this application, sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project; and, be it		
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco certifies that the		
10	Project conforms to the recreation element of any applicable city or county general plan; and,		
11	be it		
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco appoints the		
13	General Manager of the Recreation and Parks Department as agent to conduct all		
14	negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications,		
15	agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the		
16	aforementioned project.
