1	[Pedestrian Safety Intersection of Broadway Street, Columbus Avenue, and Grant Avenue.]

3	Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic to install a Scramble Signal at
4	the intersection of Broadway Street, Columbus Avenue, and Grant Avenue.

7	WHEREAS, The intersection of Broadway Street, Columbus Avenue and Grant Avenue
8	is difficult and dangerous to cross on foot; and
9	WHEREAS, Residents have expressed concern with the speed of traffic and length of
10	pedestrian crossing intervals at that intersection; and
11	WHEREAS, Scramble signals provide exclusive pedestrian crossing intervals at
12	dangerous intersections; and
13	WHEREAS, Scramble signals have proved extraordinarily effective in improving and
14	encouraging pedestrian flow in high traffic areas; and
15	WHEREAS, The high volume of vehicular traffic at the intersection of Broadway Street,
16	Columbus Avenue, and Grant Avenue make it difficult to cross on foot; and
17	WHEREAS, Pedestrian traffic reduces reliance on automobiles and improves the
18	livability of our city; and
19	WHEREAS, It is necessary for the City to enhance pedestrian accessibility at this
20	intersection; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Public Transit to
22	install a Scramble Signal at the intersection of Broadway Street, Columbus Avenue, and Grant
23	Avenue to facilitate street-crossing and encourage pedestrian traffic in the area.
