

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant – Life and Annuity Consumer Protection Program]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**
4 **of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$50,000**
5 **through the California Department of Insurance for a program entitled “Life and**
6 **Annuity Consumer Protection” for fiscal year July 2006 through June 2007.**

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to establish a certain
9 project designated the Life and Annuity Consumer Protection Program to be funded in part
10 from funds made available through the California Department of Insurance (hereafter “DOI”);
11 now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of
13 the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds from DOI for
14 the purposes of life and annuity insurance fraud prosecution purposes; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of
16 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for life and
17 annuity insurance fraud prosecution purposes, including any extensions, augmentations or
18 amendments thereof; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to
20 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all
21 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the
22 purpose of securing Life and Annuity Consumer Protection Program grant funds and to
23 implement and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant
25 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the

1 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and that the grant recipient and the authorizing
2 agency will hold DOI harmless from any claims that may arise from the use of grant funds;
3 and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
5 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
