

1 [Support Goals for Federal Funding – Community Development Block Grant]

3 **Resolution supporting Fiscal Year 2007-2008 Community Development Block Grant**
4 **(CDBG) Action Plan Goals.**

6 WHEREAS, Under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as
7 amended, and related federal regulations, the City and County of San Francisco is eligible to
8 apply for and receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding from the U.S.
9 Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

10 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco anticipates receiving approximately
11 \$21,000,000 in CDBG Program funds from HUD in 2007-2008; and,

12 WHEREAS, On behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the Mayor's Office of
13 Community Development (MOCD) is preparing to release a Request For Proposals (RFP) for
14 the 2007-2008 CDBG Program; and,

15 WHEREAS, The RFP is in concert with the MOCD Consolidated Plan for program
16 years 2005-2009; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Consolidated Plan was approved by HUD in 2005; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Consolidated Plan details the Mayor's Office of Community
19 Development and Mayor's Office of Housing seven goals for the CDBG Program: 1) Promote
20 economic self-sufficiency for low- and moderate-income families; 2) Strengthen neighborhood
21 vitality; 3) Increase the provision of timely, relevant and effective social services; 4) Promote
22 equity-based public policy strategies; 5) Create housing opportunities for the homeless; 6)
23 Create affordable rental housing opportunities for individuals and families with incomes up to
24 60% of San Francisco median income; and 7) Create homeownership opportunities for

1 individuals and families up to 100% of San Francisco median income, and support existing
2 homeownership programs including funding housing counseling agencies to advise eligible
3 San Franciscans of existing homeownership programs, for families up to 120% of median
4 income; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors continues to support the seven
6 2005-2009 CDBG Consolidated Plan goals, and the related 2007-2008 Request For
7 Proposals to achieve these goals.
