

1 [Ratification of prior professional service contracts for health and behavioral health services
2 and approval of three year extensions.]

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4 **Resolution ratifying prior professional service contracts for the San Francisco**
5 **Department of Public Health for health and behavioral health services and approving**
6 **three year extensions.**

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8 WHEREAS, the mission of the Department of Public Health is to protect and promote
9 the health of all San Franciscans; and

10 WHEREAS, the budget for the Department of Public Health includes annual funding for
11 over three hundred million dollars in professional service contracts to provide health and
12 behavioral health services to residents of San Francisco; and

13 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health provides health and behavioral health
14 services through a wide network of over three hundred community-based organizations and
15 service providers; and

16 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Charter requires that contracts entered into by a
17 department or commission having a term in excess of ten years, or requiring anticipated
18 expenditures by the City and County of ten million dollars shall be approved by the Board of
19 Supervisors (Section 9.118 (b)); and

20 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health has previously entered in to contracts that
21 cumulatively exceed 10 million dollars and /or ten years and anticipates that professional
22 service contract renewals and modifications in fiscal year 2006-2007 will result in contract
23 expenditures in excess of ten million dollars or terms in excess of ten years for health and
24 behavioral health services; and

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1 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health has a policy to use multi-year agreements
2 based on satisfactory performance by a contractor; and

3 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health plans to enter in to professional service
4 contract renewals and modifications in fiscal year 2006-2007 that will be multi-year
5 agreements if prior performance by a contractor is determined by the Health Commission to
6 be satisfactory; now, therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies the prior professional service
8 contracts for health and behavioral health services, a list of which is on file with the Clerk of
9 the Board of Supervisors in File No. ; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby approves three year
11 extensions of the professional services contracts a list of which is on file with the Clerk of the
12 Board of Supervisors in File No. , for health and behavioral health services subject
13 to a finding by the Health Commission that prior performance by a contractor is satisfactory.
