## Resolution proclaiming December $10^{\text {th }}$, 2006, as CESP Day in San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors recognizes the Center for Elderly Suicide Prevention and Grief Related Services (CESP), and Dr. Patrick Arbore, for his work with depressed, lonely and suicidal seniors in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, CESP is in its $25^{\text {th }}$ year of operation and is the first program of its kind in the United States; and

WHEREAS, CESP has gained national recognition for its innovative programs, and serves more than 30,000 depressed, suicidal, ill and lonely seniors annually; and

WHEREAS, adults 60 years of age and over have the highest rate of suicide in this country; and

WHEREAS, CESP operates a 24 -hour crisis line called the Friendship Line, for older adults or their advocates that focuses on the immediate issues of depression, grief, suicidal thoughts, abuse, chronic pain or loneliness is the only service of this kind in the United States; and

WHEREAS, CESP also provides telephone calls to older clients who are identified as at-risk for severe depression or suicidal behavior, and does face-to-face counseling visits and grief counseling; and

WHEREAS, 8,000 hours are required each year to keep CESP programs in operation; and

WHEREAS, CESP will hold its $20^{\text {th }}$ Annual Cable Car Caroling fundraiser on December 10, 2006 to raise funds for recruitment and training of CESP volunteers; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims Sunday, December $10^{\text {th }}$, 2006, as CESP Day in San Francisco.
