3 **Ordinance amending the Traffic Code to restrict parking or standing by vehicles on**
4 **Turk and Larkin Streets and on Golden Gate Avenue adjacent to the Phillip Burton**
5 **Federal Building at 450 Golden Gate Avenue to law enforcement vehicles authorized by**
6 **the Federal Protective Service of the Department of Homeland Security.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding Section
12 32.6.36, to read as follows:

13 SEC. 36.6.36 PARKING CONTROL, PORTIONS OF TURK STREET AND GOLDEN GATE
14 AVENUE.

15 (a) No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or
16 unattended at the following locations:

17 (1) on the south side of Turk Street, between Larkin and Polk Streets; and

18 (2) on the north side of Golden Gate Avenue, between Larkin and Polk Streets.

19 (b) The restrictions in subsection (a) shall not apply to official law enforcement vehicles
20 permitted to park in these locations by the Federal Protective Service of the Department of Homeland
21 Security, except when parking prohibition regulations for street-cleaning purposes are in effect.

22 (c) Any vehicle found in violation of this Section shall be subject to removal under Section
23 22651(n) of the California Vehicle Code.

24 Section 2. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding Section
25 32.6.37, to read as follows:

1 SEC. 32.6.37. PARKING CONTROL, PORTION OF LARKIN STREET.

2 (a) No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or
3 unattended on the west side of Larkin Street, between Turk Street and Golden Gate Avenue.

4 (b) The restrictions in subsection (a) shall not apply to official United States Marshals
5 Service vehicles permitted to park in this location by the Federal Protective Service of the Department
6 of Homeland Security, except when parking prohibition regulations for street-cleaning purposes are in
7 effect.

8 (c) Any vehicle found in violation of this Section shall be subject to removal under Section
9 22651(n) of the California Vehicle Code.
