RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises license to John Gardiner and Joseph Banks, located at 1369 Folsom Street, will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

Conditions: (1) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee(s) as defined on the ABC0257 dated 10/11/2006. (2) No person under the age of twenty-one (21) years of age shall sell, furnish, or deliver alcoholic beverages. (3)

(4) Petitioner shall not permit its patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the sidewalks adjacent to the licensed premises. The orderly standing of patrons in line to enter the premises shall not be considered loitering or unlawfully congregating. (5) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (6) Petitioner(s) shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Department. (7) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance the conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed. (8) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences. (9) At no time shall any person under the age of 21 years enter or remain in the public premises. 

The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
