13	Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates		
14	by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning		
15	Department in its letter dated August 1, 2002, which stated that this project is in		
16	conformity with the San Francisco General Plan and the priority policies of		
17	Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said letter is in the Clerk of the Board of		
18	Supervisors File No. and is incorporated herein by reference.		
19	Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No.		
20	176,696, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No.		
21	, Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the		
22	Width of Sidewalks," a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors		
23	Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding		
24	thereto a new section to read as follows:		
25	Section 1571. The official sidewalk widths on the westerly side of Stockton Street shall be as shown on Department of Public Works drawings Q-20-616,		

1	copies of which are in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File		
2	<u>No</u> .		
3	Section 3. The Department of Parking and Traffic, as is necessary as a		
4	result of this Ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility companies		
5	and City Departments for the relocation, modification, or both of existing utility		
6	facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas.
