24	1. The membership of the Veterans Affairs Commission has a goal to be		

representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

1	2.	Applicant Jill Buck, an appointee who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person	
2		with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Veterans Affairs	
3		Commission.	
4	3.	The Veterans Affairs Commission has attempted to fill the position, for which Jill	
5		Buck was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the	
6		specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this	
7		time. The Rules Committee has certified that Jill Buck is qualified to serve on the
