12	Section 1. (a) Environmental Findings. The Planning Department has determined that		
13	the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California		
14	Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said		
15	determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. and is		
16	incorporated herein by reference.		
17	(b) Additional Findings. As a result of a computer generated error, the Department of		
18	Public Works selected an additional building consisting of three (3) units in the 2007		
19	condominium conversion lottery. These 3 units would exceed the annual condominium		
20	conversion limit of 200 units as set forth in Section 1396 of the Subdivision Code. This		
21	egislation would waive the 200-unit limit in order to allow the conversion of this single 3-unit		
22	building. This legislation will serve the public interest as it will compensate for this error and		
23	will not negatively affect the selection of any building in the 2007 condominium lottery,		
24	including the assignment of buildings to the stand-by list.

5	elete three (3) units from the 2008 condominium conversion lottery so that no more than 19		
6	units are selected for conversion that year. The three (3) units shall be removed from the Pool		
7	B portion of the condominium lottery as set forth in Section 1396.1.
