8	under the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for mass transportation
9	projects; and
10	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA), City and County of San
11	Francisco is an eligible claimant for FTA Bus and Bus Facilities capital assistance projects
12	under Section 5309 of TEA-21; and
13	WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations
14	on the applicant, including providing the local share of project costs; and
15	WHEREAS, The local share of project costs will be provided separately using a variety
16	of sources, which may include Regional Bridge Toll Net Revenues, San Francisco Municipal
17	Railway Improvement Corporation Funds and/or sales taxes administered by the San
18	Francisco County Transportation Authority; and
19	WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) requires that in connection
20	with the filing of an application for federal assistance, the applicant give an assurance that it
21	will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the DOT requirements under that
22	Act; and
23	WHEREAS, It is the goal of the MTA that Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs)
24	be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definitive
25	procedures shall be established and administered, consistent with federal law, to ensure that

7	7 WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation of the MTA (or his design	nee) must execute	
8	agreements to complete transfer of the funds; and		
9	9 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and		
10	WHEREAS, There is no allowance for indirect costs; now, therefore, be it		
11	RESOLVED, That on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the MTA is		
12	authorized to accept and expend \$3,887,113 in federal Section 5309 Bus and Bus Facilities		
13	capital assistance for design and construction of MUNI's Islais Creek facility; and, be it		
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
15	5 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it		
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional		
17	information or assurances may be requested by the funding agencies in connection with this		
18	8 request; and, be it		
19	9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any	and all agreements	
20	necessary to complete transfer of the funds.
