5	Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Grant Funds.						
6	DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively enter into an agreement with Tenderloin						
7	Health, to participate in a project to expand oral health services offered in the Tenderloin						
8	neighborhood to homeless, HIV-positive individuals. Tenderloin Health is the recipient of a						
9	grant award from the federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) for the						
10	Special Projects of National Significance program. Tenderloin Health and DPH –TWHC have						
11	agreed to enter into an agreement to participate in the project, wherein Tenderloin Health will						
12	pay DPH – TWHC \$1,841,000 from this award with a period of April 1, 2007 through						
13	December 31, 2011.						
14	In additio	on to the 6 positi	ons (1.05 FTEs) approved through thi	s ASO amendment,			
15	funds will also be used to partially pay for the salaries of two existing staff members, including						
16	the 2230 Physician Specialist (Medical Director) and 2593 Health Program Coordinator						
17	(Dental Director), both of which will be funded at .05 FTE through this agreement. DPH is						
18	further authorized to furnish whatever additional information or assurances the funding agency						
19	may request in connection with this agreement, and execute any and all agreements						
20	necessary to complete the transfer of funds. The terms of the grant agreement prohibit						
21	including indirect costs in the grant budget, thus the Board of Supervisors hereby waives						
22	inclusion of indirect costs in the budget.
