# Review of Budget Process

November 2017 BLA Report on BOS Budget Process Recommended:

- BOS to produce a list of annual policy priorities to submit to the Mayor for incorporation in the proposed budget.
- BLA to produce a budget overview report as part of the annual budget review.
- Amend the Administrative Code to revise budget process timelines.

#### 2018 Budget Priorities

Last Year, the B&F Committee held hearings on:

- □ Street Cleaning
- □ Homelessness and Affordable Housing
- □ Public Safety
- □ Other Issues of Concern

### 2018 Budget Priorities

Last Year, the Board Passed the Following Resolutions regarding the FY 2018-20 budget:

- □ Resolution 125-18, urging specific city-wide street cleaning priorities
- Resolution 134-18, urging specific city-wide homelessness priorities
- Resolution 150-18, urging specific crossdepartmental priorities

### Status of 2019 Budget Priorities

- BLA has solicited the top 3 budget priorities from each Board office.
- □ The following issues have been identified:
  - Homelessness/Housing
  - Public Safety
  - Mental Health and Substance Abuse
- BLA will work with Board offices to further refine priorities.

# Moving Forward

- □ BLA will conduct research on each priority including:
  - Status of established programs
  - Historical spending
  - Performance measures
  - Other quantitative measures of progress
  - Identification of funding impact opportunities
- □ April 10, 17, 24: BLA topic specific presentations

### Goals

- Budget priorities to be provided to Mayor's Office for preparation of proposed budget
- BLA research to assist Supervisors in understanding the City's performance, challenges, and opportunities in critical policy areas
- Priorities may provide framework for Board during add-back process
- The budget priorities process can be further improved for future cycles
