  9 City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to Article IX, Section 2.80-1 and 2.81 of the San Francisco
  10 Administrative Code; now therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, that the Examiner and the Chronicle, a newspapers of general circulation 11 published in the City and County of San Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic news 12 and intelligence of a general character, having a bona fide circulation of at least 50,000 copies per 13 calendar week, printed in the City and County on three or more days in a calendar week, is hereby 14 designated as an official newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco, commencing July 1, 2007 15 for the publication of all official advertising of the City and County which is required by law to be 16 published one time, other than advertising required by Section 2.103 of the Charter for special meetings 17 of the Board of Supervisors and its special or standing committees, and all official advertising of the 18 City and County which is required by law to be published more than one, but not more than three times 19 per week for a specified number of weeks, and, be it 20 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Contract Administration is hereby authorized to
