10	to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria through the Regents of the University of California to		
11	support the Triangulation Resource Guide project; and,		
12	WHEREAS, DPH's HIV Epidemiology Section will use these funds to 1) assist in the		
13	production of a generic resource manual presenting in detail the triangulation method for		
14	analyzing, interpreting and using data; 2) contribute to the production of case studies		
15	delineating triangulation exercises; 3) participate in the Malawi Triangulation training		
16	workshop; and 4) attend the Malawi Global Fund evaluation planning meeting; and,		
17	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the Global Fund to Fight AIDS		
18	Tuberculosis and Malaria through the Regents of the University of California requires the City		
19	to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the		
20	Board of Supervisors in File No. 070891; which is hereby declared to be a part of this		
21	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
22	WHEREAS, the grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses		
23	the department for two existing positions, including Epidemiologist III (Job Class 2804) at .05
