3	Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend
4	450,000 of TransLink® funds from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission to
5	provide resources to oversee the installation and testing of TransLink ${ m I\!R}$ equipment on
6	Muni vehicles.
7	WHEREAS, TransLink ${}^{l\!$
8	transit riders in the Bay Area to use a single high-tech "smart card" to pay fares on different
9	public transit systems; and,
10	WHEREAS, The TransLink® Consortium, comprised of the Metropolitan Transportation
11	Commission (MTC) and various Bay Area transit agencies, including the City and County of
12	San Francisco, through its Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA), is a forum for joint agency
13	decision-making for the ownership and operation of $TransLink{}^{\mathbb{R}}$ in the Bay Area; and,
14	WHEREAS, The MTC has funded the development of TransLink ${}^{I\!\!R}$ through a
15	combination of federal, state and regional grant funds; and
16	WHEREAS, The MTA has applied for $450,000$ in TransLink® funds from the MTC to
17	provide resources to oversee the installation and testing of TransLink ${\ensuremath{\mathbb R}}$ equipment on Muni
18	vehicles; and,
19	WHEREAS, On February 26, 2007, the governing body of the TransLink® Consortium,
20	the TransLink® Management Group, approved funding of \$450,000 to the MTA for the above
21	purpose; and
22	WHEREAS, On April 17, 2007, the MTA Board of Directors authorized the MTA,
23	through its Executive Director/CEO, to accept and expend \$450,000 from the MTC to provide
24	resources to oversee the installation and testing of TransLink ${\ensuremath{\mathbb R}}$ equipment on Muni vehicles
25	and commended the matter to the Board of Supervisors for its review and approval; and

1	WHEREAS, There is no allowance for indirect costs; and
2	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; now,
3	therefore be it
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Municipal Transportation
5	Agency to accept and expend \$450,000 of TransLink® funds to provide resources to oversee
6	the installation and testing of TransLink $^{ m I\!R}$ equipment on Muni vehicles; and be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect
8	costs in the grant budget; and be it
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional
10	information as may be requested by the funding agency in connection with this request; and,
11	be it
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any and all agreements
13	necessary to complete transfer of the funds.
