| 11 | Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:  |
| 12 | Section 1. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.46   |
| 13 | to read as follows:  |
| 14 | SEC. 12.46. AUTHORIZING THE RECREATION AND PARK COMMISSION TO  |
| 15 | MODIFY GOLF COURSE HOURS AND FEES, AND CREATING THE GOLF COURSE TASK   |
| 16 | <u>FORCE.</u>  |
| 17 | (a) In order to provide the Recreation and Park Commission with greater flexibility to                                   |
| 18 | maximize both utilization of golf courses and financial return, the Commission is authorized to                          |
| 19 | organize special promotions and events, and to modify the hours of play and fees at all courses under                    |
| 20 | its jurisdiction. The Commission may increase or decrease existing golf fees as set forth in this Article                |
| 21 | 12 no more than fifteen percent (15%) per year in addition to any adjustments authorized by Sections                     |
| 22 | 12.12(g) and 12.20(b) of this Article.   |
| 23 | (b) There is hereby created a Golf Course Task Force to advise the Board of Supervisors. The                             |
| 24 | objectives of the Task Force shall be to reduce General Fund support for the operation and                               |
| 25 | maintenance of the golf courses, and to explore alternative revenue sources.   |

| 1  | The Task Force shall consist of nine (9) eleven (11) members, appointed by the Board of                   |
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| 2  | Supervisors, who shall each serve terms of three (3) years 18 months. The Task Force shall include: 1)    |
| 3  | the Director of the Department of Public Health, or his or her designee; 2) the General Manager of the    |
| 4  | Recreation and Park Department, or his or her designee; 3) the President of the Recreation and Park       |
| 5  | Commission, or his or her designee; 4) one member of a San Francisco-based organization advocating        |
| 6  | for recreation programs and facilities; 5) one member, who regularly golfs, of a San Francisco-based      |
| 7  | organization serving senior citizens; 6) one member of a San Francisco-based organization serving         |
| 8  | youths; 7) one member of a San Francisco-based organization serving "at risk" youths; 8) one member       |
| 9  | of a San Francisco-based organization advocating for open space and environmental issues; and 9)          |
| 10 | one three members of a San Francisco-based organization advocating for golfers. The Recreation and        |
| 11 | Park Department shall staff the Task Force.   |
| 12 | The Task Force shall: 1) evaluate measures that increase golf course use; 2) consider                     |
| 13 | appropriate adaptive reuse of golf course land; 3) establish a three-year 18 months fiscal viability plan |
| 14 | to reduce General Fund support for operating and maintaining the course; and 4) create a financial        |
| 15 | feasibility plan, which shall include ideas for increasing revenue from facilities, suggestions for       |
| 16 | effective marketing campaigns, cost-containment recommendations, budgetary parameters, strategies         |
| 17 | for philanthropic sponsorship, and any other budgetary proposals. The Task Force shall submit             |
| 18 | reports to the Board of Supervisors every six (6) months, and shall submit its final report three (3)     |
| 19 | years 18 months from the effective date of this ordinance. The Task Force shall expire by operation of    |
| 20 | law three (3) years 18 months from the effective date of this ordinance.                                  |
