| 15 | WHEREAS, There is no allowance for indirect costs; and  |
| 16 | WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and                         |
| 17 | WHEREAS, On June 19, 2007, the MTA Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 07-083,                 |
| 18 | which authorized the acceptance and expenditure of \$217,970 in State grant funds from the California |
| 19 | Air Resources Board for the purchase of low-polluting construction equipment; now, therefore, be it   |
| 20 | RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Municipal Transportation Agency to             |
| 21 | accept and expend \$217,970 of State grant funds from the California Air Resources Board for the      |
| 22 | purchase of low-polluting construction equipment; and, be it  |
| 23 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect costs in                 |
