9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	
11	Section 1. The San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby amended
12	by adding Chapter 5, Section 3.500, to read as follows:
13	Sec. 3.500 ETHICAL MEETING CONDUCT BY MEMBERS OF BOARDS, COMMISSIONS
14	AND ADVISORY BODIES
15	(a) A member of an elected or appointive board, commission or advisory body of any kind
16	established by the Charter or legislative act of the United States of America, the State of
17	California or the Board of Supervisors may not participate in a meeting of that member's board,
18	commission, or advisory body while that member is compromised by alcohol or illegal drugs
19	(including prescription drugs not used in accordance with the prescription). For purposes of
20	this ordinance, a member shall be considered to be compromised if that member is impaired in
21	his or her communication, comprehension, adherence to the rules of order applicable to the
22	meeting, ability to maintain physical control, or ability to exercise professional judgment in
23	carrying out the business of the City and County of San Francisco or if that member consumes
24	alcohol or uses illegal drugs after the commencement of a meeting of the board, commission, or
24 25	advisory body and before the conclusion of such meeting.

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1		(b) A member of an elected or appointive board, commission or advisory body who observes	
2		conduct by another member of that board, commission or advisory body in violation of this	
3		ordinance, or which the member in good faith believes is in violation of this ordinance, shall file	
4		a complaint with the Ethics Commission alleging a violation of this ordinance.	
5		(c) The Ethics Commission shall investigate and act upon any alleged violation of this	
6		ordinance using the procedures established under Section C3.699-13 of the Charter. All	
7		members of the board, commission, or advisory body involved in the investigation shall	
8		cooperate with the investigation. When the investigation is complete, the Ethics Commission	
9		shall forward a report summarizing its findings to the appointing authority, if any, of the	
10		member who is the subject of the investigation. The Ethics Commission report shall not be	
11		<u>confidential.</u>	
12		(d) Violation of this ordinance or failure to cooperate with an investigation of an alleged	
13		violation of this ordinance shall be considered official misconduct within the meaning of Section	
14		<u>15.105(e) of the Charter.</u>
