WHEREAS, In accordance with Penal Code Section 933.05(c), if a finding or
recommendation of the Civil Grand Jury addresses budgetary or personnel matters of a
county agency or a department headed by an elected officer, the agency or department head
and the Board of Supervisors shall respond if requested by the Civil Grand Jury, but the
response of the Board of Supervisors shall address only budgetary or personnel matters over
which it has some decision making authority; and,

WHEREAS, The 2006-2007 Civil Grand Jury Report entitled "Continuity Report - Have
 City Agencies Done What They Said They Would Do After the Civil Grand Jury of 2005-2006
 Issued Its Reports?" is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_,
 which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,
 WHEREAS, Recommendation No. 3 of the subject Civil Grand Jury Report states: "The

Board of Supervisors should respond to each individual recommendation directed to it by the
 Civil Grand Jury. The responses should be made to the Presiding Judge of the Superior
 Court within 90 days of the release of the report"; and,
