12	both term licenses to certain CA software and perpetual licenses to certain other CA software
13	and maintenance for such software (the "Agreement"); and
14	WHEREAS, The initial term of the Agreement was for a period of nine years; and,
15	WHEREAS, Such term was extended to September 29, 2007; and,
16	WHEREAS, DTIS has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to extend
17	the Agreement for both the perpetual and term software and maintenance for an additional
18	three years; and,
19	WHEREAS, Charter section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations," subsection (c),
20	requires Board of Supervisors approval of any contract that has a term of ten or more years;

22	WHEREAS, Administrative Code section 21.30, "Software Licenses, Support, Escrow,
